

Covid-19 Safety Measures when attending CPC Sunday Services

In order to minimise the risk of Covid-19 transmission at CPC services the following safety measures have been introduced. The church will be deep cleaned before every service.

- 1. If you feel ill with a temperature, cough or have reduced taste or smell or if you are in a household which is self-isolating you must not attend.**
- 2. Face coverings are to be worn and put on before entering the church. Children under 3 are exempt. Children are to be closely supervised by their parents or guardian.**
- 3. Hands are to be cleaned with hand sanitizer when entering the church.**
- 4. No singing is to take place as this promotes the production of aerosols and droplets.**
- 5. In order to plan seating allocation members and visitors must inform CPC at least two days in advance of the service and include the names of any other persons in their family group. Everybody must arrive in good time before the service starts and confirm their attendance and contact details to the stewards.**
- 6. A one-way system with signage will be in place and stewards will show the congregation to their allocated seats. Congregants can bring in their own seating cushion as permanent cushions have been removed from the pews.**
- 7. After using the toilets hands to be washed with soap for 20 seconds and then dried with paper towels.**
- 8. At the end of the service the congregation will leave the church by the side door in the hall. Hand sanitizer will be provided as you leave.**
